
European Alternative for Belarus and Preparation of a Roadmap for EU Integration

Resolution by the Democratic Forces of Belarus



We, the democratic forces of Belarus,

Affirm:

- The future of Belarus lies in the European Union. This is a geopolitical choice that guarantees Belarusians' freedom, dignity, and prosperity;
- Despite the Lukashenka regime's attempts to sever Belarus from Europe, Belarusian society remains committed to European values – democracy, human rights, and the rule of law:
- Belarus has been and remains part of European civilization. Today, this choice is an alternative not only to the "Russian world" but also to political dependency, repression, and economic deadlock;

Emphasize:

- European integration of Belarus is a strategic contribution to regional security, curbing Russian influence, and defending democracy in Eastern Europe;
- In 2023, we officially announced Belarus' European perspective through the
 Declaration of Future Membership of Belarus in the European Union and have since
 worked consistently to bring our country closer to Europe through expertise,
 partnerships, and diplomacy;
- The adoption by the Coordination Council of the Memorandum on the Abolition of the Death Penalty in Belarus, supported by the United Transitional Cabinet, the People's Anti-Crisis Management, civil society, and human rights organizations, is the first step towards the future accession of Belarus to the Council of Europe;

Welcome:

- the signing of the Letter of Intent on Cooperation between the European Parliament and the democratic forces of Belarus, as well as the European Economic and Social Committee;
- the work of the EU-Belarus Consultative Group, the Council of Europe's Contact Group on Belarus, and the National Platform of the Eastern Partnership Civil Society Forum;
- the establishment and work of delegations of the democratic forces of Belarus in the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe and in the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe, composed of delegates from the Coordination Council;
- EU support for Belarusian civil society, independent media, and political prisoners;

Announce:

- the start of preparations for the Roadmap for Belarus' Integration into the Council of Europe and the EU;
- our readiness to hold a high-level EU–Belarus Conference as a symbolic and strategic step towards Belarus's rapprochement with the European Union;

the expansion of partnerships with national parliaments of EU member states;

Call on:

- EU institutions and member states to strengthen academic, cultural, and informational exchanges between the EU and Belarusian society;
- all parties to take measures to overcome visa barriers, limited recognition of qualifications, and political obstacles preventing Belarusians from participating in EU mobility programs;
- Belarusians around the world to join in promoting the European alternative through participation, education, and joint action.

Our goal is a European Belarus, a Belarus that belongs to its citizens, a Belarus they are proud of.

The European alternative is not a dream but a future we are beginning to build today. It requires clarity, consistency, and action. We are open to cooperation with all who are ready to make this alternative a reality.
