

ON PROTECTING SOVEREIGNTY AND PREVENTING BELARUS FROM BEING DRAWN INTO WAR

Warsaw, Poland, 08–09.08.2026

Recognizing that the illegitimate Lukashenka regime has consistently been complicit in Russia's aggression against Ukraine by providing its territory, airspace, infrastructure, and other resources for the preparation and execution of Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine in 2022, as well as for the continued support of Russia's war of aggression;

Noting the systematic militarization of Belarus, ranging from the use of Belarusian enterprises to support Russia's defense industry to the militarization of society, including children and young people through the education system and military-patriotic programs;

Observing the ruling regime's inability to pursue an independent security policy due to its systemic lack of domestic and international legitimacy, as well as its lack of political will to maintain genuine independence from Russia;

Taking into account Ukraine's reports of the systematic use of Belarusian territory and economic resources to support Russia's aggression, including the deployment of drone relay stations, the use of Belarusian airspace, the sale of fuel and products of Belarus's defense industry to the armed forces of the Russian Federation, as well as other provocations being prepared with Belarus's involvement;

Taking into account statements by the NATO Secretary General and the military intelligence services of NATO member states indicating that Russia could attack NATO's eastern flank between 2027 and 2030;

Proceeding from the understanding that any military confrontation between Russia and NATO in the Baltic states or Poland — particularly in the area of the Suwałki Corridor — would inevitably involve the territory of Belarus;

We, the democratic forces of Belarus,

- **demand** the immediate cessation of all support for Russia's aggression and **reject** any use of Belarusian territory, airspace, infrastructure, or armed forces to carry out or facilitate aggression against other states
- **call on** the international community to use all available political, diplomatic, and economic instruments to bring such support to an end;

- **take seriously** the risks of Belarus being drawn further into the war, including the possibility that Russia could use Belarusian territory and armed forces for new military operations or other provocations against Ukraine and NATO member states;
- **strongly condemn** any actions or omissions by the ruling regime that facilitate these threats, as such conduct is contrary to the national interests of Belarus and does not reflect the will of the Belarusian people;
- **recall** that Belarusian territory has repeatedly been drawn into military conflicts without the consent of the Belarusian people or the participation of their legitimate representatives, with catastrophic consequences for human life, the economy, the environment, and the country's historical and cultural heritage, ultimately threatening the very existence of the Belarusian nation;
- **declare** that preventing the recurrence of such scenarios must be a top priority for every Belarusian politician, public official, and member of the armed forces;
- **commit ourselves** — and call on all citizens of Belarus, regardless of their political views — to do everything possible to preserve peace in Belarus and to actively oppose, at every level, any attempt to draw our country into war.
